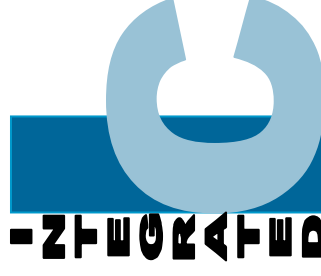

infection control evaluation and review

An infection control evaluation can be undertaken to confirm that the practice is meeting the requirements of AS/NZS4815:2006. Recommendations for improvement will be provided in written format. On-going reviews are recommended and priced by the hour.

infection control protocol (non-customized)

The company will provide your practice with an easy to follow dental specific Infection Control Protocol that you can implement with your staff. No consultation required.

customized infection control manual

standard operating procedures

implementation and training

practice audits
